# GRAPHICAL CHARTER

## DESCRIPTION

The visual identity of **VETTUBE** must be used with the greatest possible coherence and must follow the strict graphic rules that are described in this charter.

The basic rules of use of the logo and graphic elements must be fully respected in order to avoid any transformation likely to weaken the impact of this identity.

## THE SYMBOLISM

The logotype is the first sign of recognition of a trade mark, that which gives it its identity. Therefore it must respect clearly defined rules. The logotype has been developed under the designation **VETTUBE** and can only be used under this name.

The simplicity of the logo is in harmony with a refined graphic environment. It allows a perfect readability and gives the basic pictogram the freedom to exist.

## **THE POSITIVE LOGO**

The **VETTUBE** logo possesses a minimum protection zone defined by the height of the main text. It is prohibited to place the logo in a loaded zone that does not ensure the respect of this minimum space. The composition of the colours must follow the values mentioned below, according to the used mode. The logo should preferably be used on a white background, in its positive version.


The present document cannot be used for calibration of the colours. For this, you should encode the values of the colours in the spectrum according to the desired use.

# THE NEGATIVE LOGO

The **VETTUBE** logo can be used in negative in certain cases. Two versions are at your disposal.

The logo should preferably be placed on a one-colour background, but can also be placed on photographs as long as the visibility and readability remain sufficient. When the logo is presented on a blue or light background, only the white version should be used.













# **PROHIBITED USED OF THE LOGO**

It is prohibited to use the main logo in situations that can make it less visible, prevent its recognition, modify its form or/and its colour, or in situations that do not respect its protection zone or remove or introduce new elements.




















## **THE COLOURS**


